






#### DETAILED CRAFTSMANSHIP!




#### 2-RADIUS TRACK for realistic layouts!

#### PAINTED CARS for authentic finish!



#### No. HO-310 GILBERT 3-CAR DIESEL FREIGHT

Squint your eyes just a bit when this GM Diesel freight drag comes ghosting along the high iron and you'll swear you're watching the real McCoy. That's because it has all the pinpoint detail of prototype, from the General Motors "A" unit powerhouse with universal drive (all 3 wheels pull the load) right back to the shanty which rides the rear. Freight rolling stock trucks are equipped with double springs which provide absolute realism and serve as equalizers, minimizing derailments. Two-rail track provided measures 126": rails are flat top "T" type and sleepers are spaced 14" apart. Train measures 24" long.


## Gilbert HO Track and Track Equipment

The more mainline and siding you have, the more fun you'll have with your HO model pike. Gilbert HO track sections and equipment are realistic in appearance and easy to install. Rails are made of brass, are "T" shaped for best traction and sleepers are spaced 1/8" apart. Every fourth tie is drilled for spiking track to table, if desired.

#### PICK YOUR RADIUS!

Gilbert HO Track comes in both 15" and 18" radius, permitting a variety of layouts, realistic double track system and space compactness. Photograph shows difference: inside track is 15" radius; outer loop is 18" radius.







#### GILBERT HO STRAIGHT TRACK

Brass rails mounted on life-like insulated ties spaced ½" apart. Comes in full, ½ and ½ lengths for any layout requirement.







#### HO-625 GILBERT 90° CROSSING

You can have one mainline intersect another at a 90-degree angle on your HO pike with this piece of track equipment that allows interesting and realistic track schemes. Each crossing leg measures 6" long.






\$4.50 HO-620 RIGHT HAND RE-MOTE CONTROL SWITCH

The more switches you have the more interesting is your train operation. Sidings, spur lines and classification yards all need right and left switches. This one operates by remote control and has right hand turn-out.

#### **HO-626 BUMPER TRACK**

You'll want several of these for your deadend sidings to give your pike realism and finish. Bumper unit is molded; brass rails bend to form V. Track section is 4".



HO-621 LEFT HAND REMOTE CONTROL SWITCH

Operates by remote control and is same construction as switch described at left, except has left hand turn-out.

#### No. 25 SMOKE CAPSULES

Nothing will increase the realism of your HO steam locomotives like real smoke puffing from the stack (only Gilbert HO has this feature) and these handy capsules contain enough smokeproducing fluid for two fillings. Fluid is contained in leak-proof capsule; when top is snipped off fluid is squeezed into smoke stack. Heating element in locomotive creates smoke in matter of seconds and puffs are timed with action of driving wheels. Package illustrated below contains dozen replacement capsules and funnel.






#### The Greatest Boon An HO Railroader Ever Had!

#### HO-630 AUTOMATIC RE-RAILER

Consists of three pieces which mount on and beside track as shown. When car with dragging truck passes through section wheels are automatically put back on the rails. Also makes it simple to put cars on track initially — one sweep of hand and cars are railed.




#### GILBERT HO-650 POWER PACK

Designed to operate Gilbert HO trains and remote control switches, by reducing standard household 110-120 volt alternating current to 18 volts, A.C. (for switches) and by converting the low voltage A.C. to 12 volts D.C. for efficient train operation. Contains self-setting thermal circuit breaker which cuts out whenever a short or overload develops, protecting the Power Pack. Has throttle-type speed controller. 5½" long x 4½" wide.

Power Pack has  $1\frac{1}{2}$  amps output for top train performance!
